# Soccer Philosophy

## **We are not as technically sound**

In the US, teams typically train only 3 or 4 days a week. Many clubs outside the US train an additional day per week. In the US, we lack pickup games that round out the 10,000 hours needed to become your best. For us, the best way to accumulate hours is to control the school day and school year.

## **We are not as technically aware**

Many clubs cram 4 or more teams per pitch making it impossible to do tactical training and rehearse set pieces. We will dedicate no less than half a pitch to our teams.

## **We do not play enough games against quality opponents**

We will seek to measure ourselves against the best competition we can find. To do that, we will need to travel and will do so cost-effectively. For us, that means going to where the talent density is greatest and playing multiple games while there. Our destinations include the best of the US, Europe, and South America.



# Professional Pathway


## UEFA Pro/A Licensed Coaches
